- O My medicine cabinet is well equipped.
- O I have enough light sources (candles, torchlights and batteries) at home.
- O I've also informed the neighbours.

# Warning the population



**Siren signals** 



### Warning

Wailing sound (high-low) 1 minute

#### All clear

Continuous sound 1 minute

#### Alarming emergency personnel

Continuous sound 1 minute – 2 x interruption



#### **Cell Broadcast**

If danger is imminent, Cell Broadcast will send a warning message directly to your mobile phone.



## Warning app NINA

The warning app NINA provided by the federal government delivers important civil defence warning messages for different perils.



## **Warning vehicles / Announcements**

Warning vehicles of the fire brigade, police and relief agencies will be out in the city area making public address calls to inform and warn the people.



# **Emergency radio**

In the event of an extensive blackout, emergency information will be broadcast on the frequency of Radio Mülheim 92.9 MHz. This may be picked up for example with crank, battery or car radios in analogue.

# Emergency call and information points (German: NIP) of the municipality of Mülheim an der Ruhr

## What are NIPs and where to find them

NIPs are fixed or mobile spots which will be manned by members of the fire brigade and relief agencies in the event of failure of an emergency call/phone grid failure or extensive blackout.

Emergency calls can be redirected by radio from here.

You can also get information on the current situation at the NIPs. Memorise your closest NIP so as not to lose any time in case of emergency.


